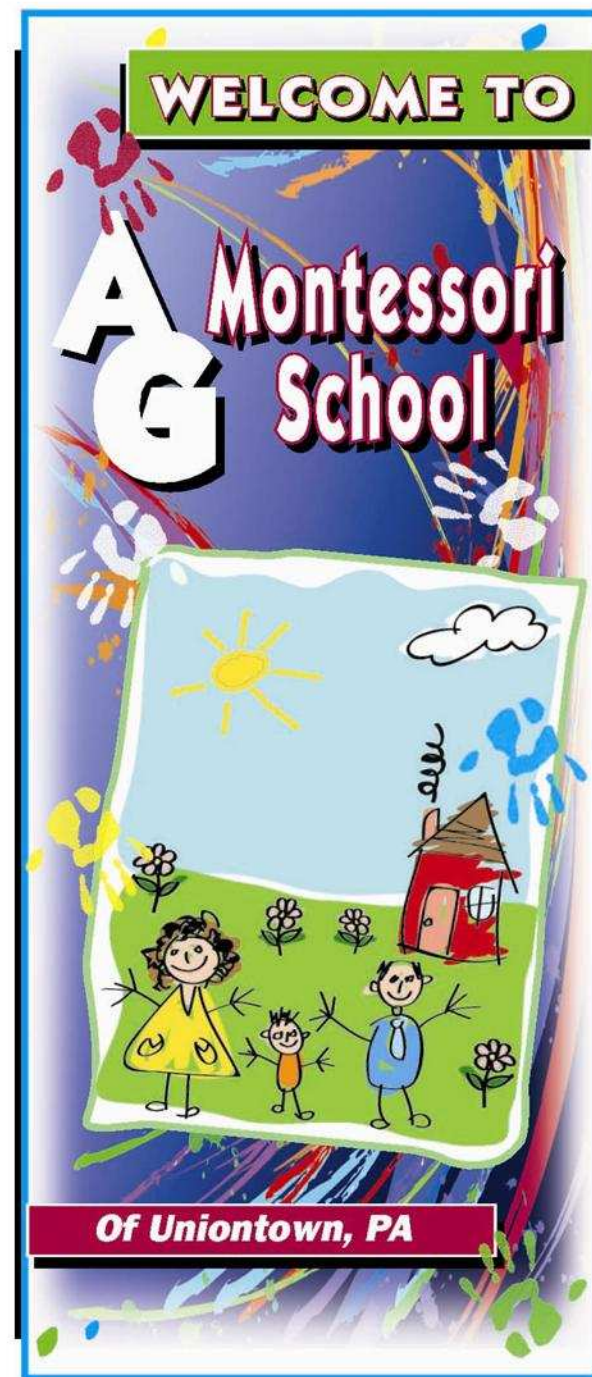
**ABOUT MRS. MARJORIE MURPHY,

The Montessori approach recognizes the innate desire children have to learn about and explore their world.



Each child is an individual and is encouraged to learn and develop in a personally unique way.



Our classroom is a beautiful, inspiring environment that meets each child's needs and interests with a wide variety of activities available for their choice in a child-size, home-like setting.



The children enjoy their "work" with the classroom materials, and understand that learning gives them happiness, satisfaction, and a sense of who they are.



Having children of different ages in the same classroom allows the younger children to observe and learn from the older children, while the older children reinforce their skills and learn to be thoughtful, caring leaders.

Our flexible scheduling includes half and full days, or a combination of the two.
Extended care hours are also available.

The cost is well below the national Montessori school average - comparable to local childcare centers.

Scholarships are available.

Weekly Spanish lessons are included in tuition.

Private music lessons may be arranged with a visiting teacher.

Bus transportation is an option for Kindergarten students.
